LABORERS

- 1) General Labor work: assembling (tying), handling, and installing rebar cages into piles, steel tension bars, pipe piles, and other steel works.
- 2) Frequent shoveling, pressure washing, sweeping, lifting, pushing and pulling up to 50 pounds, stooping, carrying, and bending.
- 3) Clean equipment daily and as directed by Foreman.
